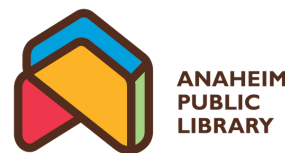

Adult Book Club

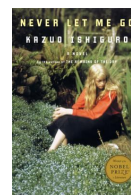
